In June, Susan was able to take a few days away and join several other pastors' wives from across BC for a time of retreat. It is an annual retreat hosted by one of the other fundamental Baptist churches in BC. With fundamental Baptist works being so far apart in the central part of British Columbia, this is the one time of the year for the wives to come apart from the various ministries and spend some time in spiritual renewal and encourage one another during the fellowship.
